

Notice of Race

The 2025 Windycrest Spring Open Regatta

Keystone Lake, Tulsa, Oklahoma May 17-18, 2025

CLASSES: All boats welcome. Three boats in the same class make a fleet. All others sail in an appropriate handicap fleet. Classes currently anticipated: Handicap keelboats and centerboards, J22, Catalina 22, MC Scow, Sunfish, Hobie Wave, Hobie 17, Hobie 20 and Flying Scot

RULES: The ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 under Section 2 as adopted and amended by US SAILING and the Local Appendix will govern races. A boat entering as a member of a class must conform to class rules.

SCORING: Low point system:

1 for 1st, 2 for 2nd, 3 for 3rd, etc. DNF=# of finishers in fleet +1 point DNS=# of entries in fleet

DSQ= # of entries in fleet + 1 point

Boats must have a sail number to be scored.

If 5 or more races are completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

HANDICAPPING: Current US SAILING Portsmouth System, Skippers should verify that a US SAILING Portsmouth D-PN number has been established for their boat.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The sailing instructions will be available on https://windycrest.com and after 17:00 on May 16 at Windycrest Sailing Club.

TROPHIES: 1st place for 3-boat fleets, 2nd place for 5boat fleets, and 3rd place in 7-boat fleets, 4th place for 9boat fleets and 5th place for 11-boat fleets.

HOUSING: Free camping at Club with bathhouse. Hotels in Sand Springs and Cabins at Keystone State Park.

FACILITIES: Clubhouse, bathhouse, boat ramp, ample parking, mast-raising device, tie-up dock and end of slip space for overnight in the water.

FOOD & DRINK: Continental breakfast will be served on Sat. & Sun. mornings. Lunch fixings will be available on Sat. for on-the-water lunch. Saturday supper tickets are available at additional cost. (See payment page)

ENTRY FEES AND COSTS: \$20.00 per person participating. Single handed \$20, double \$40, triple \$60, etc. Junior sailors (17 and under) sail for free. Notify Blake Kelso of your intention to attend; Registration will be in person on May 16 & 17.

DIRECTIONS: Address: 761 Windycrest Rd., Sand Springs, OK. From Tulsa, take Highway 412/64 west of Sand Springs, exit at 209th West Avenue (Prue Rd.), turn right. Drive five (5) miles north (just past Big Al's Store and the Elk's Lodge) and look for the Windycrest sign on the left (Windycrest Rd.). Follow Windycrest Rd. to the open gate at the end of road and look for place to park to rig your boat.

REGISTRATION: Advance registration is not required, but is appreciated in order to anticipate trophies. Early registration may be made by email to the regatta chairman. Fees may be paid upon arrival.
