



Notice of Race

The 2026 Windycrest Spring Open Regatta

May 16-17, 2026

Keystone Lake, Tulsa, Oklahoma

CLASSES: All boats welcome. Three boats in a class make a fleet. All others sail in an appropriate handicap fleet. Classes currently anticipated: Handicap keelboats and centerboards, J22, Catalina 22, MC Scow, Sunfish, Hobie Wave, Hobie 17, Hobie 20 and Flying Scott

RULES: The ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 under Section 2 as adopted and amended by US SAILING and the Local Appendix will govern races. A boat entering as a member of a class must conform to class rules.

SCORING: Low point system:
1 for 1st place, 2 for 2nd, 3 for 3rd, etc.
Boats must have a sail number to be scored.
If 5 or more races are completed, a boat's total score will be the sum of her race scores, excluding her worst score.

HANDICAPPING: Current US SAILING Portsmouth System. Skippers should verify that a US SAILING Portsmouth D-PN number has been established for their boat.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The sailing instructions will be available on <https://windycrest.com> and after 17:00 on May 15th or at Windycrest Sailing Club.

TROPHIES: 1st place for 3-boat fleets, 2nd place for 5-boat fleets, and 3rd place in 7-boat fleets,

HOUSING: Free primitive camping and limited RV sites with electric at WSC. Hotels in Sand Springs and Tulsa, Cabins, camping and RV sites at Keystone State Park.

FACILITIES: Open 2-story pavilion lakeside, modern bathhouse with showers, 3-wide boat ramp, ample parking, mast-raising device, tie-up dock and end of dock space for overnight on the water.

FOOD & DRINK: Registration includes continental breakfast on Sat. & Sun. mornings, box lunch on Sat., and post-race rehash refreshments.

Saturday supper tickets are available at additional cost. Planned menu is pulled pork sliders w/ sides, plus beer, wine and theme drink. (See payment page)

REGISTRATION: Includes commemorative T-shirt, 2 breakfasts and a boxed lunch.
